





## V. Marriage in Lithuania

The Civil Code defines marriage as a voluntary agreement between a man and a woman who

reached 18 years old (in some cases younger). The local Civil Registry office is responsible for registering marriages (http://www.lsa.lt/lt/nariai-savivaldybes). There is a possibily to register marriage in a traditional religion institution. There are several recognized traditional religions in Lithuania: Roman Catholicism, Eastern Orthodoxy, Evangelical Lutheranism, Reformed Church, Islam Sunni, Karaites, Old Believers Orthodoxy, and Judaism. All the documents for marriage issued in

other countries should be officially translated into Lithuanian and proven by a notary.
